Item 5. Other Events

A lawsuit was filed on September 16, 1999 in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio on behalf of purchasers of the common stock of Century Business Services, Inc. ("Century") within the inclusive period of February 6, 1998 through November 23, 1998 alleging false and misleading statements concerning Century's acquisition costs, revenue run rates and goodwill amortization periods. The Plaintiff in the lawsuit is a former shareholder of Century. The Plaintiff alleges actual damages in the amount of \$48.125 suffered by the Plaintiff on the purchase and sale of 70 shares of common stock of Century. Century believes the lawsuit is without merit and intends to defend it vigorously.
